LAUNCH OF INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS IN THE CITY OF LILONGWE

On **Friday 30 July 2021**, Lilongwe City Council will launch **the first phase** of infrastructure projects to be carried out in the 2021/22 financial year by Lilongwe City Council with funding support from UNDP, Roads Fund Administration and Malawi Government. The launch will take place at the Area 18 / Senti Bridge from 9.00 am. In this phase, the following infrastructure projects will be carried out:

1. Drainage improvements in some flood disaster prone areas of the City namely Area 49 along Mteza Road, Mtandire at Kankodola School and Kaliyeka near Chipasula Sec School. This is being implemented with funding support from UNDP to the tune of MK149.0million.
2. Construction of box culverts across Mchesi River on Biwi to Penyenye Road and Nankhaka River on Area 18 / Senti Road at a contract sum of Mk566.0million.
3. Rehabilitation of Chipiku Plus to Onions buildings Road in Area 4 and pothole patching on Senti to A25 Road in Area 51 at a cost of MK291.0million.
4. Street solar lighting of the Interchange at a contract sum of MK97.0million.

The second phase of infrastructure projects will include the following:

1. Rehabilitation of Malangalanga Road, Bwaila (Devil) Street, Lower Bwaila Hospital Road from Wulian shop to Old Town Bus Depot.
2. Rehabilitation of Junction to Presidential Highway to Junction with Kaunda Road via Old Gulliver (A49).
3. Upgrading to bituminous standards of Makatani (Area 12) to Area 44 Road via Kauma Market.
4. Upgrading to bituminous standards of A25C to Dzenza Road.

The awards of contracts for these roads is awaiting 'no objections' from the Government procurement regulatory authorities.

The third phase will involve three roads as below. The first 2 roads were tendered out in June, 2021 and are under review by Lilongwe City Council before submission to relevant procurement regulatory authorities for 'no objections'. The third one has just been advertised in the newspapers for contractors to compete for the works.

1. Upgrading to bituminous standards of Penyenye (NCIC road) to Mtaya (6miles) Road via Mtsinje village.
2. Upgrading to bituminous standards of Mtandire to Airwing Road.
3. Resealing and widening of Mchesi to A23 Market Road.
